

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An awareness Camp on "Financial Literacy of SHG Members":

An awareness Camp on "Financial Literacy of SHG Members" was organized with a conjoined effort of Department of Accountancy and Department of Commerce of the college on 26th December, 2021. More than 80 members from 11 numbers of Self Help Group (SHGs) operating in Tulungia village participated in the camp. The names of the SHGs are: Aaimoni, Tejimola, Asha, Ma,



Binapani, Kiran, Ramdhenu, Namita, Lucky, Tora, and Majoni. All the participants were female of the age between 18 to 70 years. The major objectives of the camp were: (a) to identify the current status of financial literacy of the participants in order to determine the necessary steps to improve the same, (b) to make them able to solve some basic arithmetics that are required in a SHG to run (c) to make the participants aware about some of the government support programs as well as micro investment avenues and (d) to make them realize the strength of unity for a business to start and operate.



Two Assistant professors namely-Dr. Haripriya Dutta and Mrs. Pratyshi Tamuly of Department of Accountancy were entrusted with the responsibility to conduct the camp. The camp was held at the eclassroom: 3 of the college in order to provide audio-visual learning experience to the participants. The camp was begun with the playing of a short story on SHG members that could effectively draw the

attention of the participants. Followed by that, they were asked about various aspects of their financial knowledge, behavior and attitude for identifying their state of financial literacy. They were identified with low level of financial knowledge, especially numerical abilities. Therefore, they were taught some of the basic calculations such as: division of loan amount among members, calculation of simple and compound interest etc. Thereafter, another interesting story on the journey of 7 SHG members to build the brand of Lijjat Papad was played for the participant to learn and realize the capacity of

united effort. They were also introduced with various other success stories of SHGs of India as well as Assam.

Further, the participants were made aware about various governmental support programmes such as: Deendayal Antyodaya Yojna of NRLM, Assam Skill Development Mission, schemes under Khadi Development Board etc. They were suggested to take the advantages of National Saving Certificate (NSC), Kishan Vikash Patra (KVP), LIC, R-PLI, PM Suraksha Beema Yojna (Death cum disability) etc. A comparison between LIC and PLI was also shown in order to facilitate them on their investment decision.

Towards the end of the programme a game called "Balloon and the toothpick" was played to reinforce the thought of unity in minds of the participants. Both the department are looking forward to organize necessary follow up camp soon.






National Science Day Program on 28th February 2022:



As per the directives of DHE Govt. of Assam under the Pragyan Bharati Scheme the students whose parental income was below 2 Lakhs were given free admission. It is worth mentioning that the college enrols students in science streams of HS and UG for the first time in the history of the college. The beneficiaries under the Pragyan Bharati Schemes were also verified by visiting atleast 10% of student's homes by the admission committee.

the NSS volunteers undertake various activity in the school among lower

An interview schedule has been prepared with fifteen items considering demographic, economic and livelihood factors (Annexure-I). The purpose of the survey is to know the demographic, economic and livelihood pattern of sampled the household. The volunteers



have been divided into six groups to collect the data from sampled respondents and the volunteers successfully collected the information. After completing the survey, the six groups draw the map of respective survey area in school field.

In afternoon, the volunteers stage a street play on "Say No to Drugs" in Tulungia market place of adopted village. The theme of the street play is to create awareness of bad side of drug and its consequences. The nine volunteers act in the play in different role. The general public appreciates the awareness street play and encourages the team.

Three Days Workshop on SOUL Software:








World Environment Day:




World Blood Donor Day:
