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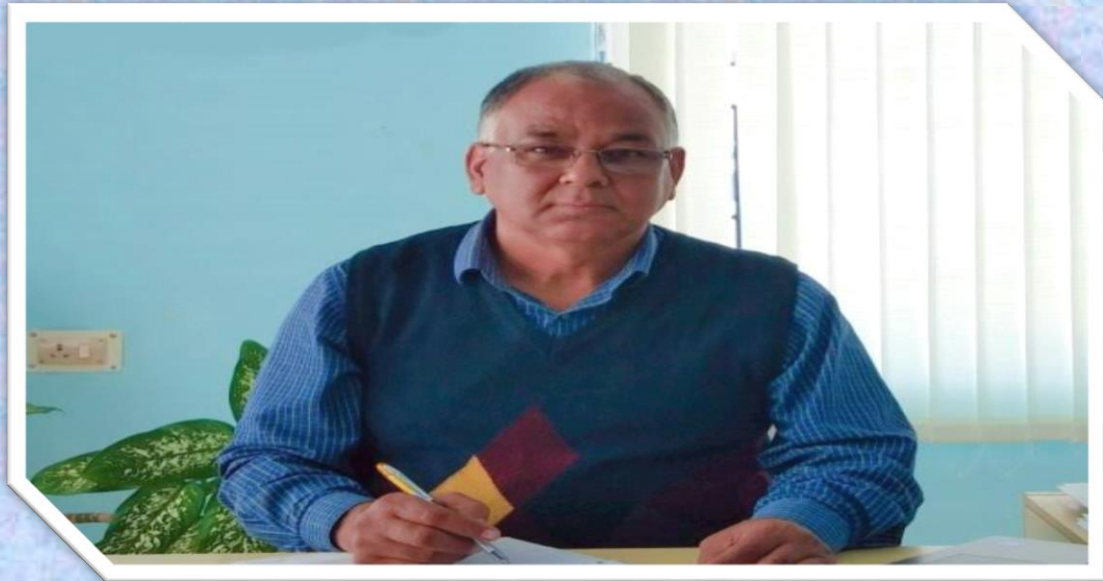
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From The Desk of the Principal



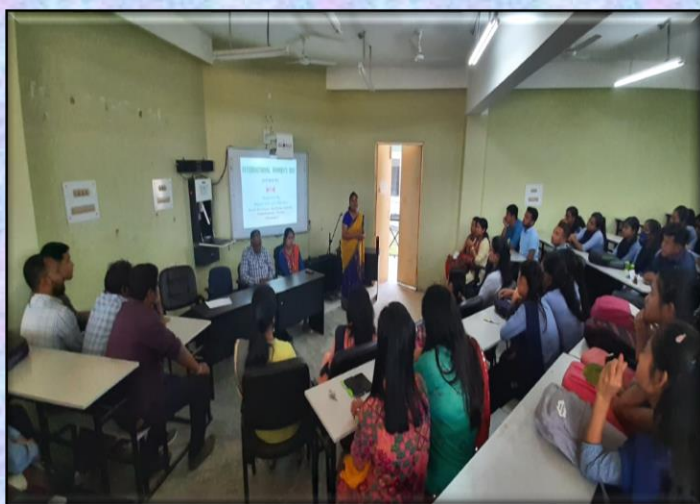

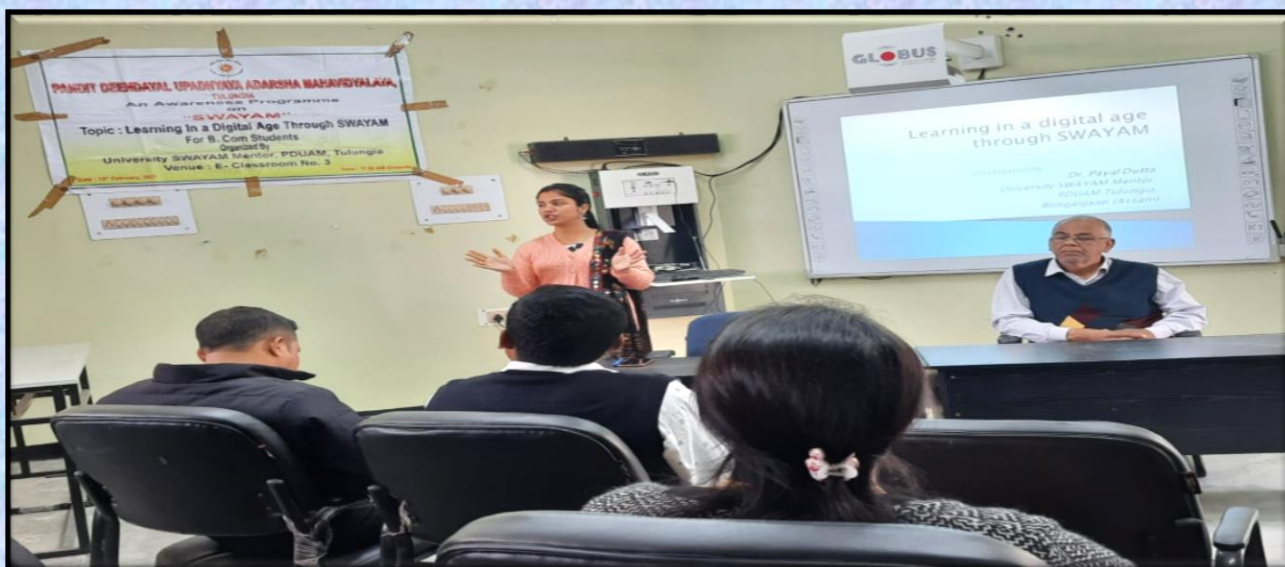

Awareness Programme on Swayam: An awareness programme on SWAYAM (Study Webs of Active Learning for Young Aspiring Minds) was organized on 12th February 2021 from 11.00 am onwards for the B.Com students of the college. The programme was held in E-Classroom No. 3. The topic of discussion was "Learning in a digital age through SWAYAM". The programme started with a welcome address by Dr. Payal Dutta, University SWAYAM Mentor of the college, followed by a speech delivered by Dr. Gunindra Das, Principal of the college. 

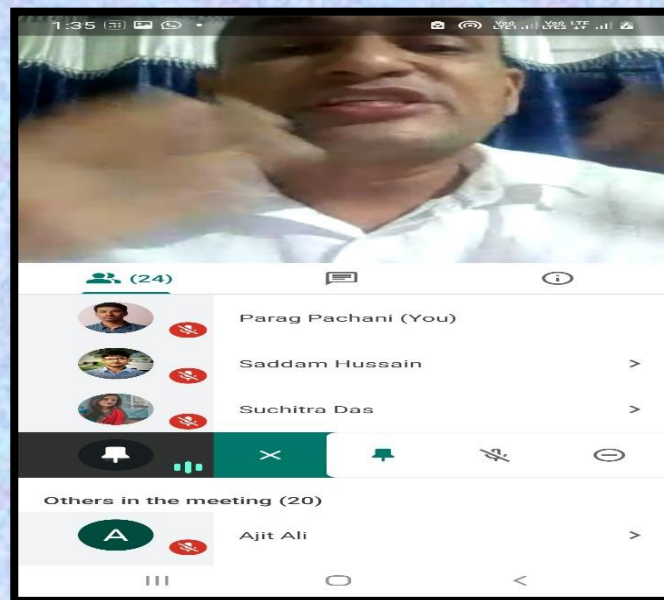
